PROJECT SPECIFICATION

1. Scope:

The contract is for the provision of terrain maintenance services at the reservoirs, pump stations and Water Care Works within Mogale City Local Municipality's area of jurisdiction.

The Contractor shall ensure that all flowerbeds, paved areas, beton covered areas and embankment area are kept tidy and weed free; and includes the removal and disposal of grass cuttings, other organic debris, any paper, cardboard and/or litter found on site, as well as sand, gross solid material on the paved areas.

The Contractor will be utilizing their own labourers, equipment and transport for the provision of terrain maintenance services of the reservoirs, pump stations and Water Care Works. The Contractor shall provide the chemical weed killer for the control of weeds, and the Contractor shall apply these to the affected areas, and areas indicated by the Specialist: Wastewater Treatment.

The Contractor shall perform above scope of work on the Flip Human Water Care Works' premises, the Percy Stewart Water Care Works' premises, the Magaliesburg Water Care Works' premises, the 11 (eleven) portable water reservoirs and pump stations premises and 1 (one) sewage pump station premises.

The scope of work on the Flip Human Water Care Works' premises – the total grassed area inside the plant's existing electrical fencing, including the hostel area and the two (2) operator's houses' areas. Furthermore, the total area outside the electrical fencing up to the tarred entrance road which surrounds the booster pump station, balancing dam, bio-filters, anaerobic digesters, the total entrance area between the (two) existing auto – and manually controlled entrance gates, and the total area between the entrance-tarred road and the instant lawn farm, up to the operators' house fencing.

The scope of work on the Percy Stewart Water Care Works premises – on the total grassed area inside the existing plant fence, including the entrance area directly outside the main gate.

The scope of work on the Magaliesburg Water Care Works premises – on the total grassed area inside the existing plant fence, including the entrance area directly outside the main gate.

The scope of work on the reservoirs, portable water and sewage pump station – the total area grassed inside the premises, including the entrance area directly outside the main gate as well as 1m outside perimeter if the existing fence.

The duration for the provision of terrain maintenance services at Mogale City Local Municipality reservoirs, pump stations and water care works will be approximately two years.
