1.5 Failure on the part of a bidder to submit a B-BBEE Verification Certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by the South African Accreditation System (SANAS), or a Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors (IRBA) or a sworn affidavit confirming annual turnover and level of black ownership in case of an EME and QSE together with the bid, will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.

1.6 The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- (f) "comparative price" means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can be utilized have been taken into consideration;
- (g) "consortium or joint venture" means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- (h) "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by an organ of state;
- (i) "EME" means an Exempted Micro Enterprise as defines by Codes of Good Practice issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (j) "Firm price" means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs or excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- (k) "functionality" means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- (I) "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- (m) "person" includes a juristic person;

- (n) "QSE" means a Qualifying Small Enterprise as defines by Codes of Good Practice issued in terms of section 9 (1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- (o) "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
- (p) "sub-contract" means the primary contractor's assigning, leasing, making out work to, or employing, another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
- (q) "total revenue" bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act and promulgated in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;

Should any damages occur as a result of negligence on the part of the Contractor, he/she shall be responsible for costs in this regard.

8. Construction of Brick walls:

- Bricks to be Burnt Clay Brick / Engineering bricks complying to SABS 227 to be approved by engineer.
- Foundation specification and size to be determined on site by the engineer. Concrete foundation to be paid under concrete works.
- Brickwork bond to be 1:3 cement: sand mortar.
- Construction to be English bond.
- Brick works to be paid per meter square.
- Rate is inclusive of all plant requirements, supply and install and the removing and disposing of material, finishing of area.

9. Stone Pitching:

- Trimming slopes and preparing slopes and excavated areas, backfilling with suitable material and compacting.
- Supply, hauling and placing all stone, grouting, concrete and the complete construction thereof.
- Rate is inclusive of all plant requirements, excavation, and compaction, reinstatement of layers and surface area to 1m behind pitching, supply and install and the removing and disposing of material, finishing of area.

10. Gabions:

- Trimming slopes and preparing slopes and excavated areas, backfilling with suitable material and compacting.
- Supply of stone, wire mesh cages (Class A galvanized), binders and connectors, and the cost of loading, transporting, offloading, assembly and filling of the cages, and completing of the construction of the gabions.
- Rate includes packing of exposed faces.
- Rate is inclusive of all plant requirements, excavation (volume of gabions), and compaction, reinstatement of layers and surface area to 1m behind gabions, supply and install and the removing and disposing of material, finishing of area.
- Concrete flooring to be paid separately, (concrete only)
- Rate to make provision for any size of gabion prescribed by the engineer.

11. Day Works


The day work rate will be used in accordance with the General Conditions of Contract (GCC 2010) clause 37.2, for the use in determining payment for work which cannot be qualified in specific units in the schedule of quantities, or work ordered by the engineer during the project which was not foreseen at tender stage and for which no applicable rate exists in the schedule of quantities. The Contractor and the Engineer will agree on the method of recording the working hours prior to the commencement of the work. Any long period of idling at any one time which in the opinion of the Engineer or his representative is beyond that required for normal operating conditions will not be paid. An instruction regarding all work to be carried out under daywork in terms of Clause 37.2 of the General Conditions of Contract will be issued at the discretion of the Engineer. Non-working hours for any reason shall not be measured for payment.

12. Contractor's Health And Safety Declaration

In terms of Clause 4(4) of the OHSA 1993 Construction Regulations 2003 (referred to as "the regulations" hereafter), a contractor may only be appointed to perform construction work if the employer is satisfied that the contractor has the necessary competencies and resources to carry out the work safely in accordance with the Occupational Health and Safety act no 85 of 1993 and the OHSA 1993 Construction Regulations 2003.




TYPICAL PIPE BEDDING DETAILS




